



## Sensory Grant Criteria

**PLEASE READ THESE GUIDELINES BEFORE COMPLETING YOUR APPLICATION FORM**

Guide Dogs will consider a request for funding for Sensory equipment which will be of a clear direct benefit to children and young people with vision impairment(s) where no source of statutory funding will pay.

### WE DO NOT FUND THE FOLLOWING

Travel costs	Therapy sessions	Repayments of loans
Vehicle adaptations	Medical treatment	General toys
Hot tubs	Household equipment	Furnishing/white goods

Applicants aged 18 and under who are certificated or eligible to be certificated as Severely Sight Impaired (blind) or Sight Impaired (partially sighted) to be considered. Applicants will need to supply a copy of a CVI or a letter from an Ophthalmologist.

The application will need to be supported by a VI Professional working directly with the applicant at the time of the submission.

All sections of the form must be completed and signed. Any incomplete forms will be rejected.

Sensory equipment provided by Guide Dogs is for home use only. Applications will need to explain how the equipment applied for will support the applicant's everyday life. The decision to support an application will be based on the information provided. If it is deemed insufficient the application will be rejected.

Applicants will be informed of the result by letter. In the case of successful applications, a 10% contribution, will be required, including VAT. Full payment, along with the return of the order confirmation will be required before an order can be placed.

One application, including an unsuccessful application, can be made in a one year period. Successful applicants may not apply again within a two-year period for the same or similar item.



The decision to provide support will be made by a board of professionals from Guide Dogs. Every decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding this.

Funds will not be paid retrospectively or to individuals.

All grants are dependent on available funding.

It is recommended that applications are sent recorded delivery, Guide Dogs will not pay for any missing postage. We will send an email notification when your application has been received. If you hear nothing within two weeks please review your recorded delivery.
